

Spring has been a busy time at Camp Antioch!

In April we started our Beginner American Sign Language (ASL) Classes on Monday mornings. The instructor is Ms. Adonia Smith (a deaf community member, educator, author, and advocate for the deaf) along with her certified ASL interpreter/educator, Mrs. Delle Copeland.

The students in this full class have not only learned American Sign Language basics, but also about deaf culture. Our second Beginner ASL Class begins April 29th and runs through May. Hopefully a more advanced class will be scheduled this fall.

Our "campers" have also enjoyed using the Camp Antioch library twice weekly (Mondays and Thursdays) and have taken advantage of our Homework Helpers on Thursday afternoons. When students finish their study time they may enjoy making a craft or selecting a recreational activity. A big thank you goes out to our adult helpers Mrs. Susan Acree, Mrs. Karen Dingler, and Mrs. Teresa Harpole.











On the third Saturday morning of each school month kids flock to Camp Antioch for our Saturday Day Camps. In April our theme was "Gardening Fun" where campers did a science project about seeds with Mrs. Sue Cuzzort, planted flower planters out front, made flower crafts, learned a Bible story and sang some praise songs. Coming up on Saturday, May 18th from 10am-noon our theme will be "Cowboys and Plowboys", a fun day with western and farming crafts, games, Bible stories, and special music by the country/gospel "No Name Band". We encourage campers and adult volunteers to dress up that day like cowboys or farmers. We are currently in the scheduling stage for several weekday Day Camps during June and July.
