If you are re-certifying and you are not in Cleanup and Recovery select Unit 34 as your secondary. Areas to get initial certification in are as follows: Cleanup and Recovery, Chaplaincy, Feeding, Showers/Laundry, and Family Care. There is something for everyone.



PRAY FOR THE MIDDLE EAST


The intense conflict in the Middle East is a reason for Christians to pray. Thousands of people have been killed since Hamas attacked Israel on Oct. 7.

- Micah 6:8 as we learn how the Lord desires for humanity to live.
- Psalm 34:14 where God's people are called to pursue peace.

• John 14:6 as we ask the Lord to draw Israelis and Palestinians to Jesus Christ. May God bring peace to the Middle East.
